

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN POLYTECHNIC HEALTH MINISTRY OF PONTIANAK AND PHILIPPINES WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY



Polytechnic Health Ministry Of Pontianak - Indonesia and Philippines Women's University, Philippines, hereinafter referred to as "the Parties";

DESIRING to enhance the existing friendly relations between the two institutions and trough development of cooperation in the field of education;

WHEREAS, Polytechnic Health Ministry Of Pontianak and Philippines Women's University agree to cooperate on exchange programs based on reciprocity, exchange program shall promote the mutual understanding between the respective faculty, students, and scholars of the Parties;

DESIRING to enhance the existing friendly relations between the two institutions and trough development of cooperation in the field of education;

BELIEVING that the cooperation would benefit the Parties;

PURSUANT to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries as well as the procedures and policies on basic educational cooperation.

HAVE REACHED THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

ARTICLE I OBJECTIVES

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to promote mutual cooperation in education and training on a reciprocal basis and to promote mutual cooperation for the advancement of knowledge and intellectual development.

ARTICLE II SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The present MoU, without detriment to the arrangements made directly between educational institutions and/or other similar entities of both institutions, has scope of cooperation as follows:

- 1. to facilitate the exchange of:
 - a. Faculty, researchers, academic personnel, students;
 - Exchange of educational literature, research findings, publications, periodicals and other related publications, subject to standard provision of national laws and international conventions on intellectual property ownership.
- Encourage reciprocal participation in educational congresses, conferences, workshops, symposiums, training courses and exhibits in areas of mutual interest.
- To establish the partnership and capacity building between principals and teachers.
- Other academic exchanges agreed to by both universities including Double/Join Degree

ARTICLE III IMPLEMENTATION

The Parties shall implement the MoU through specific arrangements, programs or projects in accordance with available funds of the Parties and shall form an integral part of this MoU.

ARTICLE IV FUNDING

The cost of the cooperative activities under this MoU shall be funded on terms to be mutually determined by the Parties and shall be subject to the availability of funds.

ARTICLE V SUSPENSION

Each Party reserves the right, for reasons of security, public order or public health, to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this MoU which shall be effective sixty (60) days after notification has been given to the other party, through governments institutions.

ARTICLE VI CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

 The Parties shall ensure that the educational data, information, and intellectual property rights mutually provided and developed which is carried out under this Memorandum of Understanding, shall not be

- transferred or supplied to a Third Party without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- In case of specific arrangement, program or project may result in intellectual property; the Parties shall conclude a separate arrangement in accordance with their respective laws and regulations.

ARTICLE VII SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute arising from the implementation of the provisions of the MoU shall be settled amicably by consultations or negotiation, through government institutions.

ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENT

This MoU may be reviewed and amended at anytime, by mutual written consent of the Parties. Such revisions or amendments shall come into effect in accordance with the provision on entry into force.

ARTICLE IX DURATION AND TERMINATION

- (1) This MoU shall remain to have effect for a period of 5 (five) years and may be extended for the same period by mutual consent of the Parties through government institutions.
- (2) The termination of this MoU shall not affect the validity and duration of any arrangements, programs, activities or projects made under this MoU until the completion of such arrangements, programs, activities or projects.
